I Billion to See Elvis' Special

Elvis Presley will star in his second television special, Elvis Presley: Aloha Fron Hawaii, a 90-minute musical concert, 60 minutes to be taped during a live, worldwide satellite broadcast from Honolulu in January. The program will be broacast on NBC early

in 1973. The live Presley conc from Honolulu will be a global event for an estimated one bill lion viewers in 35 to 46 coun tries, adding to Presley's lis of achievements the honor of performing for more people a one time than any other en

The 60-minute portion of the concert will be transmitted live-vit-satellite at 1 a.m.

(Honolulu time) January 14 to Australia, Japan, Korea, New Zealand, Thailand, South Vietnam and the Philippines; and on January 15, the 28 nations in Eurovision will telecast it. This segment will be included

in the NBC-TV special.
