Hundreds Hurt In Concert Jam

London (AP)—Hundreds were reported injured Sunday night when a large crowd, mostly young girls, pushed toward the stage at a concert by American television actor and singer David Cassidy.

Some were treated for broken limbs, shock and hysteria, according to hospital spokesmen and ambulance drivers. One 15-year-old girl suffered a heart attack and was hospitalized.

Two security guards collapsed from exhaustion.

Cassidy left the stage as the disorders began but later resumed the concert before about 30,000 fans.
