Former teen heartthrob David Cassidy performs at 8 p.m. Sunday at the Carefree Theatre, 2000 S. Dixie Highway, West Palm Beach.

Cassidy's U.S. tour is his first in 15 years. The former *Partridge Family* member and his five-man band will perform classics from the '70s show plus hits from his solo albums.

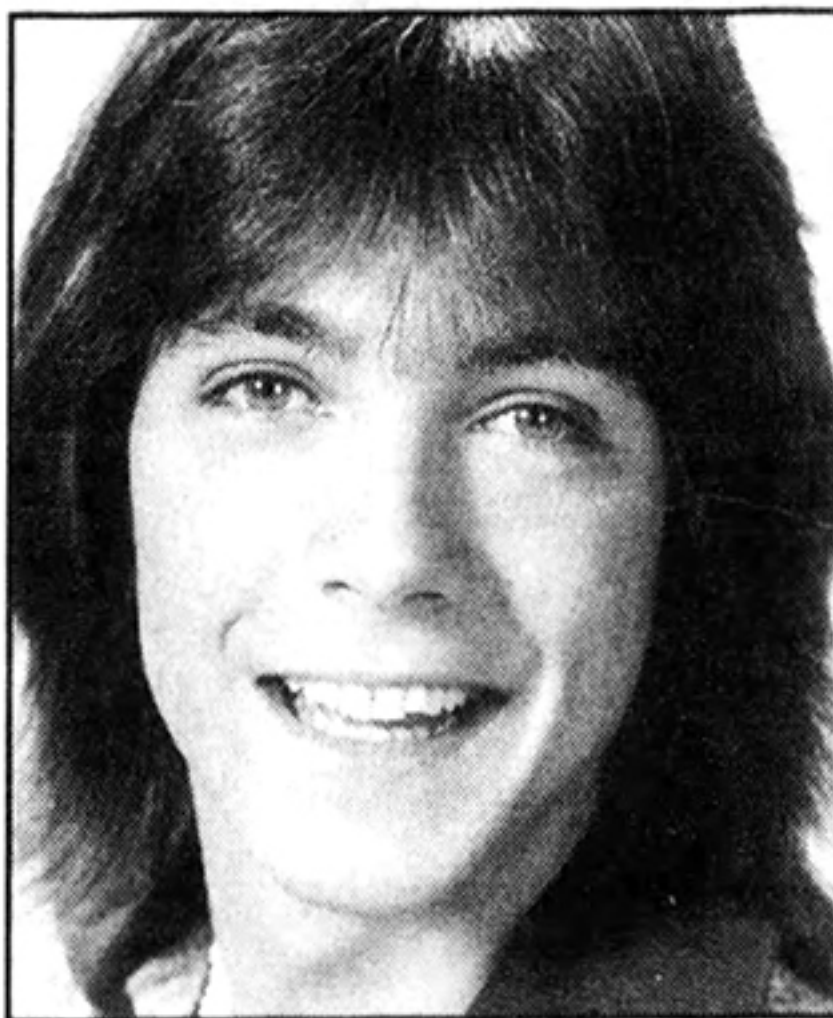
"The records that I made 20 years ago were made for a character that I was playing — they weren't mine," Cassidy told *Rolling Stone* last year, adding that he who hopes to overcome the *Partridge Family* image that plagued him even then.

"I was listening to Hendrix, John Mayall and Cream. It was a really difficult pill for me to swallow the first time I heard *I Think I Love You*."

On *David Cassidy*, his 1990 rock-blues album, the single *Lying to Myself* made it to the top 20 on the pop charts. He also co-wrote *I'll Never Stop Loving You* with his wife Sue Shifrin and Asia's John Wetton. Cher recorded the song for her latest album, *Love Hurts*.

Danny Bonaduce, Cassidy's little brother on *The Partridge Family*, opens the performance with a stand-up comedy routine based on his recent exploits and run-ins with the law.
