

Cassidy debuts at MGM's EFX

David Cassidy will make his debut in "EFX," MGM Grand's spectacular stage production, this November. He will replace Michael Crawford, who has announced that he will not be returning to the show due to an injury.

Cassidy was originally expected to appear in "EFX" in early October, but his debut will be delayed by MGM Grand's plan to make a series of new enhancements to the show.

A production praised for its use of cutting-edge theatrical technology, "EFX" has continually evolved since it opened in early 1995. Cassidy's arrival is the latest and most significant step in this evolution. His exact debut date will be announced later. In the meantime, the show continues a nightly performance schedule.

"EFX" is staged once daily at 7:30 p.m. except on Saturday, when there is a second show at 10:30 p.m. The showroom is dark on Thursday.
