Answer: That was One West Waikiki, a syndicated series that was produced from 1994 until 1996. Ladd played medical examiner Dawn "Holli" Holliday (puh-leeze), who teamed with police Detective Mack Wolfe (Richard Burgi) to solve Hawaiian crimes.

One West Waikiki is on DVD.

Question: Who does the singing in the 7-Up commercial with the lyrics about sunshine? I think it is David Cassidy. Can you help me?

Answer: It is indeed David Cassidy from his days with The Partridge Family. The song is

called "Sunshine."

Question: I remember a movie from the early 1970s (maybe made-for-TV) about a soldier during World War II who ended up on an estate owned by one of the Gabor sisters.

She took a fancy to him and refused to tell when the war ended so he would stay. Can you tell me the title and if it's on DVD?

Answer: Sounds like Wake Me When the War is Over, a 1969 TV movie with familiar sitcom faces like Ken Berry (of Mayberry RFD) as the soldier, Werner Klemperer (of Hogan's Heroes) as the town mayor and Jim Backus (of Gilligan's Island) as a U.S. Army officer. Eva Gabor (of Green Acres) is the Gabor sister in question.
